We Offer Programs Which May Interest You

- Books and Cooks: This program is for adults 18 years of age or older. We meet the third Thursday of the month at 5:30 pm. In October, we met for the first time, shared many yummy appetizers, and discussed future ideas. In November, we had Italian dishes and chose the book for December. In December, we are holding a Holiday Cookie Exchange and discussing Cane River by Lalita Tademy. This is a relaxing time to reconnect with old friends and meet new friends.

- Reading Counts Kiddos: A flyer is available online or in the library. The requirements are age appropriate and require regular reading and a project to report on the books/pages read. - Saturday Story and Craft Time: Every Saturday morning from 11:30 – 12:15, children third grade and under meet together to read books with Tina and to complete a craft.
